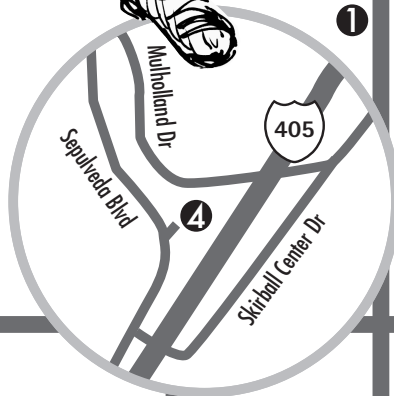

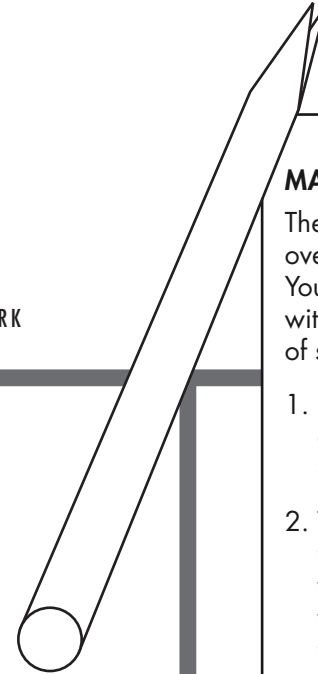

## MAKE YOUR OWN REED INSTRUMENT!

The clarinet makes noise when air passes over a thin piece of wood called a reed. You can experiment with reeds at home with plastic drinking straws and a pair of scissors.

1. Flatten the top of your straw and cut the sides near the opening in a "V" shape.
2. To play your reed instrument, place the flattened end of the straw between your lips and blow gently. Make sure you do not put too much pressure on the straw.
3. See what happens to the sound when you shorten the length of your straw or put two straws together.
